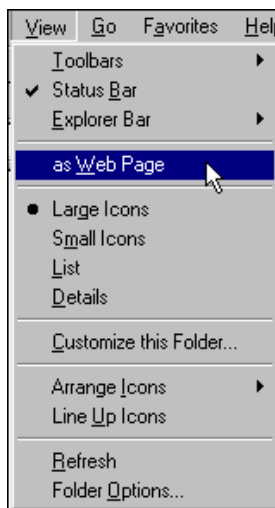


Moving Image Files from Floppy to a Folder on the Desktop

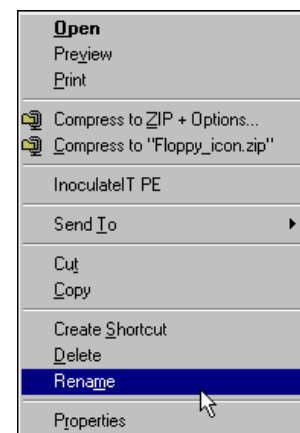
1. Eject the floppy disk from the digital camera and insert it into the floppy drive of your computer.
2. Double click on the MY COMPUTER icon on the desktop.



Double click on the 3 1/2 FLOPPY (A:) drive.



3. You should see several files named MVC-001, MCV-002, etc. These are your digital pictures. Select VIEW > AS WEB PAGE from the menu bar. This will show a preview of each file on the left-hand side of the window.



4. It is very important that you rename these files, because each time you go through this process with a new disk, new files with the same names (MVC-001, MVC-002) will over-write your existing pictures. To rename the pictures, right-click on a file, select RENAME, and type the new name for your picture.
5. Click and drag a copy of each picture to the C-R-E-A-T-E Workshop Folder you have created on your desktop.
